

## PARTICIPANT'S MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

<b>Profession</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medical Doctor</li> <li>• Physiotherapist</li> </ul>
<b>Attendance</b>	A 2-day IPC Shooting Classification Workshop.
<b>Levels</b>	<p><b>Trainee</b> After the successful completion of the 2-day course the Classifier will be able to classify his/her own country's shooters. In case that these athletes participate in International Competitions their National Classification will be ratified by an International Panel of Classifiers.</p> <p><b>Level 1</b> In order for a Trainee to become IPC Shooting International Classifier of Level 1 the following steps must be followed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maintain the National status by completing 20 classifications in their home country</li> <li>• These classifications to be validated by an International Panel at a competition or complete 20 classifications at an International competition under supervision.</li> </ul> <p><b>Level 2</b> For upgrade of Level 1 International Classifiers to Level 2 see attached pathway</p>
<b>Costs</b>	<p>Costs for attendance at an International Competition in order for a Trainee to complete these 20 supervised classifications will be covered by the participant or their home country.</p> <p>The only case that travel and accommodation costs will be covered by the organizers is when certified classifiers will be selected by IPC Shooting in order to attend International Competitions.</p>
<b>Certification</b>	<p><b>Trainee</b> Upon successful completion of the workshop and examination, a Certificate of attendance in the course will be issued The classifier would be a very valuable resource to their NPC in line with the IPC Classification Code.</p>
