Re: Qualification Slots Allocation by NPC

Dear NPC President/Secretary General,

IPC Shooting would like to inform you about the qualification slots allocation for the London 2012 Paralympic Games.

As IPC Shooting is willing to keep this process as transparent as possible we would like to describe you the way that “the List” was developed and the methods that were followed for the slots allocation by NPC:

1. Direct Slots Allocation

60 Direct Slots were allocated to NPCs in accordance with the London 2012 Paralympic Games Qualification Criteria. The final updated list was sent to the NPCs and was published on the IPC Shooting website (www.ipc-shooting.org) on 8 December 2011.

2. Qualification List (MQS) Allocation

The slots by NPC in the Qualification List (“the List”) have been calculated in accordance with the formulas and criteria that are described in the IPC Shooting Qualification Criteria for London 2012.

Attached to this Memo you will find the below information that was used during the calculation methods:

- List of athletes who achieved 2 MQS within the period 1 January 2010 and 31 December 2011
- Table of Direct Slots allocation
- Qualification List (“the List”) where the allocated slots by NPC are presented.

Each NPC must inform in writing IPC Shooting about the usage of slots that were allocated to the NPC. For that reason you are kindly asked to return the attached Confirmation of qualification slots usage form to IPC SH office (by email ipcshooting@paralympic.org or via fax at +49 228 2097209) no later than **26 March 2012**. In case of no confirmation then the provision of the Qualification Criteria document will apply.

Furthermore we would like to keep you aware of the fact that after the calculations completion **4 slots** remain unused and those will be allocated through the Bipartite Invitation allocation method. Consequently by the end of the Bipartite Invitation Allocation method **8 slots** will be allocated in total instead of 4 bipartite slots that are described in the Qualification Criteria.

Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation Slots will be made available for eligible NPCs. The deadline is **26 March 2012** and detailed information will be communicated very shortly to the NPCs.

It is important to be mentioned that the number of slots allocated by NPC will not change from now onwards even if more athletes of that NPC meet the eligibility criteria as those are described in the Qualification Guide.

By the final entries deadline (**6 August 2012**) the NPC must decide who of its overall eligible athletes will be selected for the Paralympic Games based on the number of slots that have already been allocated to the NPC.
