2010 IPC Shooting World Championships

This Championship will be held in Zagreb from 16 – 24 July 2010.

Zagreb is the capital city of Croatia with lots of sports, cultural events and many historical monuments. We have many public transportation means available, such as buses, trams, taxis, etc. Zagreb International Airport is very close to the city therefore the transportation from the airport to the competition hotels is ensured and comfortable.

The competition will be held at the Vrapčanski potok shooting range.

The ISSF 2007 World Shooting Championships took place at this shooting range.

The travelling time from hotels to the shooting range will be 15 minutes maximum. Every hotel selected by the IPC and the Organizing Committee is a 4 star hotel as a minimum, therefore comfort and accessibility are guaranteed.

This World Championships is organized by the Croatian Paralympic Committee and the Croatian Shooting Federation for the Disabled and it is an official IPC competition.



4. Competition Venue/ Training venue

Competition venue "Vrapčanski potok" is modern shooting range equipped with "Sius-ascor" electronic target, 60 firing point for small-bore discipline (50m range), 40 firing point for pistol discipline (25m range) and 40 firing point for air weapon (10m range).

There is also a restaurant and possibility to place the gunsmith and other sport equipment traders at the shooting range.

Shooting range is 6 km north-west from city of Zagreb and approx. 4-8 km from major hotels in town.

Major shooting competitions, such as the ISSF World and European Championships as well as the ISSF World Cup, were organized at the "Vrapčanski potok" shooting venue during the period 2004 - 2007.

8. Accommodation

The official Championships hotels are Hotel Golden Tulip Holiday and Hotel Antunovic. All participants will be accommodated in two hotels. Booth hotels offer 4* level services and are friendly for wheelchair users with few fully adapted rooms.

Accommodation is offered in double bedrooms.

Single rooms are available on request and with additional payment of EUR 65 per person per day.

Extra day - for those participants who will check in before 15th July and/or check out after 25th July, additional payment of EUR 80 per person/day (for those accommodated in double rooms) and EUR 130 per person per day (for those accommodated in single rooms) is required.

Participants that need to come on 14th July because of scheduled international classification on July 15th or travel arrangement, based on reasonable request and approval of LOC, will not be charged for that night separately.

The travelling time from hotel – shooting ranges will be max 15 minutes and 7 km for one way. The Competition services related to accommodation, transport, accreditation, information desk is offered only to the teams accommodated in official championships hotels.

9. Accommodation fee

ACCOMMODATION FEE - For the period of Championships the cost per person will be Euro 600.

→ Net-transfer from NPC to the Organizing Committee,

Accommodation fee covers accommodation from July 15th until July 25th.

Meals services, starting with dinner on July 15th until breakfast on July 25th.

First installment of Accommodation fee is non refundable and has to be paid no later than March 26th 2010.

According to received Accommodation Forms, LOC will make booking of the rooms.

The Accommodation fee must be paid in full for confirmed booking of the rooms based on Booking Confirmation Form that will be distributed with Final Entry Forms.

Outstanding of accommodation fee has to be paid no later than June 4th, 2010.

All payments must be made by Wire transfer on to below Bank details.

10. Doping Control

Doping control will be conducted according to IPC Anti-Doping Code.

11. Insurance

Each National Federation and/or each National Paralympic Committee are responsible for the appropriate insurance for accidents, health, property and liability of their team.

12. Accreditation

All accreditation cards will be handed out in Golden Tulip Holiday Hotel where the registration center will be held. It is important that the Team Leader of each nation arrives before or together with your first group of participants. Only the Team Leader of each country will be able to confirm accreditation of all the members of his delegation. Further information regarding accreditation will be circulated with the Second Entry Form.

13. Transportation

The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will provide transportation service from Zagreb airport /railway/bus station to hotels and from hotels to the shooting range during duration of the Championships (15-25 July 2010) and for extra days based on request.

15. Visa
